John Scully

The Galway Mercury dated October 19th 1850 carried the following report:

“His Excellency the Lord Lieutenant has been pleased to appoint John Scully, Esq., to be Resident Magistrate in the room of William Ryan, Esq., deceased, and is to take charge of the District of Outerard in the County of Galway.”

Death

The same edition reports the death of John Davis, aged 15 years, second son of John Davis, MD, Outerard on October 4th 1850. (See Obituary)

Marriage

Galway Mercury of September 20th 1851;

On the 15^{th inst.} at Knockbane (Moycullen) at the residence of her cousin A. O’Flaherty, Esq. MP by the Rev. P. Daly, VG, John Scully, RM Oughterard, Captain of the 80th Regiment, second son of J. Scully, Esq. of Feacle and brother of Francis Scully, Esq. MP of Tipperary, to Maria, only daughter of P. MacDermot, Esq. of Dermott Lodge in this County;

On the 15^{th inst.} at Outerard Church by Rev. Robert Browne, Rector of Outerard and afterwards by the Rev. James Casteaux, PP, Anna Maria eldest daughter of John Davis, MD, to Henry Frederick Ward, Esq., Lieut. Revenue police, second son of John Ward, Esq., Castleader, Norfolk, England.
