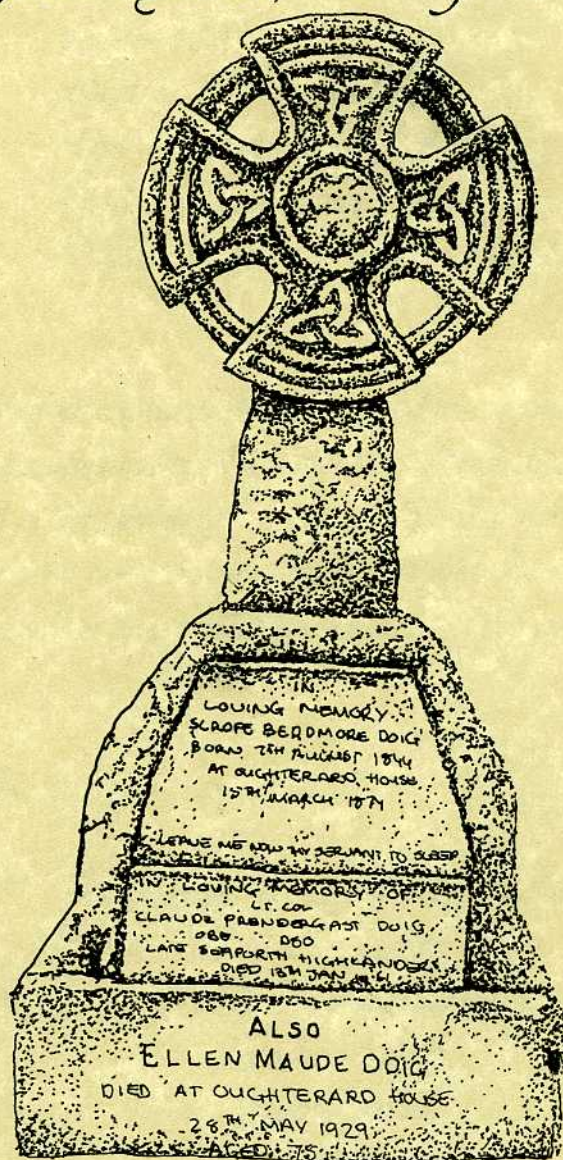

The memorial inscriptions of the Church of Ireland graveyard, Oughterard have been transcribed and computerised by the Galway Family History Society West Ltd. The project is run by the Galway Family History Society in conjunction with FAS. The main brief of the society is to computerise and make available genealogical sources for west county Galway.

It also gives a plot number (on the far right hand side of the print out) which corresponds with the memorial number in this book. This number also shows the location of the grave on the cemetery map.
